Professor Laurent Kodjikian

Laurent Kodjikian is Professor of Ophthalmology and Chair of the University of Lyon, and Associate Chair of the Department of Ophthalmology, Croix-Rousse Teaching Hospital, Lyon, France.

Professor Kodjikian's expertise spans medical and surgical retina, with a focus on age-related macular degeneration (AMD), diabetic retinopathy (DR), retinal vein occlusion, as well as infections and inflammation, including uveitis. He has been involved in more than 76 clinical trials, often examining novel therapies for AMD and DR, and notably served as the principal coordinator of the national GEFAL study. He has contributed to over 260 peer-reviewed publications and eight books to ophthalmic literature. He currently on the editorial board of the *Journal Français d'Ophtalmologie* and is a past editorial board member for the *International Journal of Ophthalmology and Clinical Research* and the *Journal of Ophthalmology*.

Professor Kodjikian is the former President of the French Society of Ophthalmology (SFO) (2018–2020) and remained editor-in-chief of its website that features a wealth of ophthalmic information until early 2022. He is also the current President of the Lyon-Oeil-Retine (LOR) congress.

Since 2005, he has served on the boards of the French Agency for Drug Security and the National French Health Agency. Further, he has been an expert on Clinical Research Projects in University Hospitals for the French Health Minister since 2009. In 2021, he was made a Knight in the National Order of the Legion of Honor, the highest French order of military and civil merit.
