Professor Xiaofeng Lin is a Doctor of Medicine, Chief Physician, Professor, and Doctoral Supervisor. He is the Deputy Director of Zhongshan Ophthalmic Center, Sun Yat-Sen University, Guangzhou, Guangdong, China, and Vice President of the hospital.

Professor Lin is committed to basic and clinical research on the prevention and treatment of proliferative vitreoretinopathy, the diagnosis and treatment of infectious ophthalmopathy, and the protection of the optic nerve. He played a role in the development of a surgical technique involving the use of a multi-point electric staring omentum incision to treat complicated retinal detachment, and a further foldable artificial vitreous technique to save and retain the severely injured eyeball. He has led several multi-center clinical research projects, notably including the China Red Eye Study, and has extensive experience in patient care.

Professor Lin is a member of the Ocular Trauma Department of the Chinese Ophthalmology Society, Vice Director of Visual Disability Rehabilitation with the China Association of Rehabilitation of Disabled Persons, and Vice Director of the Ophthalmology Specialized Committee of the Chinese Health Information and Big Data Association. Further, he is the leader of the eye trauma specialist group with the ophthalmologist branch of the Guangdong Medical Doctor Association.
